








—Joining forces with Johns Hopkins Medicine



All Children's Hospital is now a part of the Johns Hopkins Health System (JHHS) as a fully integrated member of Johns Hopkins Medicine (JHM). All Children's becomes the first US hospital outside of the Baltimore/Washington DC region to achieve membership within JHM, which includes The Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine and the Johns Hopkins Hospital and Health System.

"This is a momentous occasion, the beginning of a new chapter in the history of All Children's Hospital," said Gary Carnes, President & CEO of All Children's Health System. "Throughout its 84-year history, All Children's has grown with the needs of children to become a statewide referral center for the best in pediatric care. The goal has always been to become a national leader, not only in clinical care, but also in teaching and research to benefit future generations of children in Florida and beyond. As part of Johns Hopkins Medicine, All Children's value as a key community asset will increase

exponentially. All Children's top-notch clinical care will evolve into the future with the addition of world-class teaching and research opportunities for which Johns Hopkins Medicine is renowned. Our region and the state of Florida stand to benefit from the economic impact that such growth entails."

Serve Yourself While Serving Others

There are few things in life we can do for ourselves that also benefit others. A **charitable gift annuity (CGA)** is one of them. A CGA is a simple contract between you and us, where you agree to donate a sum of money to All Children's Hospital Foundation. In return, we agree to pay you a fixed percentage of that amount every year for as long as you live.

Funding a CGA is simple.

- Write a check
- Use a credit card
- Transfer stock

We will provide you a detailed illustration showing:

- Your personal payment rate
- Your income tax deduction for this year
- Your capital gains tax savings

When funding a CGA, you have some important decisions to make. Do you want the payments to go to you, or to you and someone else such as your spouse? The payment rate is different for two people yet remains very attractive. In addition, the payments continue for as long as either of you live. You can also have fun and fund a CGA as a gift for someone else! Just remember, there may be gift tax implications if you do. Be sure to ask us about this possibility.

Once a charitable gift annuity is funded, you will receive payments every month, or you can specify a period of every three months. Either way, the payment schedule is up to you. The payments continue at the fixed annual amount for life. Also, the payment rate is based upon the funding amount and never changes.

Hospital offers benefits that will extend far beyond our respective campuses. Johns Hopkins' commitment to its own community and to its patients has never wavered in more than a century, and we know that All Children's shares a similar commitment to its own community and patients. It is this shared vision that we will build upon with this new integration."

The transaction involved no cash, and no purchase or sale occurred. Under the terms of the integration agreement, All Children's Hospital retains its name and its longstanding commitment

to the children of Florida. Donations made to the Hospital's Foundation remain for the benefit of All Children's. Leadership and day-to-day operation of the 259-bed freestanding pediatric hospital in St. Petersburg, Florida and outreach facilities in eight west Florida counties are not expected to change. All Children's retains its voluntary medical staff and physician organizations, including those University of South Florida physicians practicing at ACH. The University and All Children's are committed to continuing the USF Residency Program at ACH through

2014, with the possibility of extending beyond that time frame still under discussion.

Board governance structure guarantees that local community leaders continue to provide guidance and oversight of All Children's as majority members of the Hospital's Board of Trustees. In fact, the Chairman of the Board of All Children's Hospital will now be a member of Johns Hopkins Medicine, and in addition, members of the Board of All Children's Hospital will be offered opportunities to serve on JHM and JHHS committees.



The deferred gift annuity, like an immediate one, features a fixed payment rate and tax benefits. Only the income tax deduction is generally higher for a deferred gift annuity.

Would you like even more flexibility in your CGA? Then consider a flexible deferred charitable gift annuity. You still receive all the benefits, but get

the opportunity to decide later if you wish to wait a little longer for the first payment. By choosing this option, you create an even higher payment rate.

Gift annuities are simple yet full of options. Whether you want payments now or in the future, a gift annuity can be an integral and powerful ally in your planning. It can supplement your retirement or simply add a little extra to your yearly income. And for the best part, you help yourself at the same time you are helping others.
